**Due to urgent need:**

Public Establishment of Electricity for Generation announces for the second time its need for the designing ,manufacturing ,supplying , transporting, testing, insuring, executing civil and electromechanical works, erecting and putting into operation and all the equipment necessary for erecting two precipitating engines power plants working on distillate oil in the industrial city Sheikh Najjar /north east of Aleppo city/on two sections:

- First plant: 4 sections with a capacity of 2 M.W  $\pm$  5% each .
- Second plant: 4 sections with a capacity of 5 M.W  $\pm$  5% each .

on a turn-key basis, including the supply of spare parts, tools and training in site with all needs to guarantee the safe operation and exploitation.

All firms are invited to participate in the tender.

This will be according to the conditions specified in the file of External Call For Tenders No.329/2017.

Those interested in participation can obtain a copy of the file from the contracts department in the Establishment between 11-12.30 a.m, during the official business hours and against payment of Euro(500) for foreigners and Arabs non Syrian or its equivalent in Syrian Pound for Syrians.

- Bid bond: /20000 / Euro only twenty thousand Euro as a bid bond for the first plant.  
/30000 / Euro only thirty thousand Euro as a bid bond for the second plant.
- Performance bond: 10% ten percent of the contract value.
- Execution period: The execution period of the project will be specified for each plant and for each section separately on turn-key basis with a shortest possible period ,and the Bidder has to specify it in his offer, and it is considered as preference element between offers and not as rejection element. It shall start from the next day of the date of commencement order.
- This Call for Tenders can be fractionalized between more than one bidder where the bidder can submit an offer for one plant or for both provided that he executes each plant completely.

- Criteria basis that will be used for tender evaluation will be as follows:  
(The total Technical marks are 100 marks, these marks will be distributed as follows: Company reference /15/ marks, Chemical and mechanical 60 marks, electrical equipment /15/ marks, control equipment /5/marks ,Civil Works /5/ marks.  
The Bidder who will score less than 75% marks will be rejected as per Article No. /6/ of the Juridical Book of Condition.
- Option period: (120) days, from the next day of the closing date for submitting the offers.
- Commitment of the awarded Bidder towards his offer is /180/ days starting from the following day of the date of notifying him the written awardness.
- The submitted prices should be final and any followed reduction will be rejected.
- The Bidder has to nominate a commercial agent in Syria dully registered as specified in article /5/ of the Financial and Juridical Book of Condition.
- The Bidder has to be bound with the regulations of all books of conditions especially paying the taxes and duties subject of article /19/ of the Financial and Juridical Book of conditions.
- The Bidder has to submit the information relevant to the Pre-Qualification subject of Para. (8) of Art. (5) Of the Financial and Juridical Book of conditions in a closed envelope.
- PEEG is not obliged to award the contract to the bidder that gave the lowest price, but it will take into consideration during the comparison of the offered prices, the technical specifications, the guarantee period, the responsibility, the costs of maintenance and operation and any other factors that may affect the final cost of the project subject of this call of tenders.
- Offers should be presented within a period terminating at 14.5 O'clock of the official business hours of dated 14 /9 /2017, to the registration office of PEEG at Mazzeh – 17 Nissan street – in front of Carlton hotel – Damascus, Syrian Arab Republic.
